

Hello,

If you have driven by the US 5 Bridge in Guilford recently, you've probably noticed utility crews at work moving poles and lines in preparation for this summer's project to replace the Route 5 bridge over Broad Brook. The Vermont Agency of Transportation expects the utility work will be done by the end of this month.

On Thursday, March 30th, tree cutting is scheduled to occur within the project area. The work will take two days and require at times alternating one-way traffic. Flaggers will assist travelers navigate through the work zone. Please use caution while driving through the bridge area.

Looking ahead, a public information meeting, will be held on **Thursday, May 25 at the Guilford Community Church in Algiers Village**. At the meeting, final plans will be presented and the contractor, Renaud Bros of Vernon, will be introduced. The bridge will be closed for 4 weeks, beginning in July.
