

Hello,

Construction work on the project to replace the US Route 5 bridge in Algiers Village, Guilford, will impact I-91 travelers beginning the week of May 22.

The Vermont Agency of Transportation's (VTrans) contractor, Renaud Bros, will begin work on reconstructing the emergency access ramp to accommodate wider turns by emergency responders who may need to use the ramp while the US 5 bridge is closed for four weeks during reconstruction.

One I-91 southbound lane will be closed Monday-Friday during the day and reopened evenings. Travelers on US 5 may experience short, periodic delays to allow trucks and equipment access to the ramp area.

VTrans will hold a public meeting on May 25 at 6:30 p.m. at the Guilford Community Church in Algiers Village to present information about the project and introduce the contractor to the public.



*The access ramp is located at milepost 5.75, south of Exit 1 in Brattleboro, across the highway from the Guilford Visitors Center.*
